Hi Gareth

Here is the original paper for the idea of a "Concept", "Demonstration" or "Innovation" site which was developed by SEPA and MS and sent to the SSPO in September 2013.

I'll not pre-empt discussion on the 17<sup>th</sup> any further but I suspect that if we were to be advancing a proposal for a site on this basis now then we'd also incorporate an element of the DZR concept within the monitoring/licensing strategy for the site. More recent discussions around the idea of a "Concept" site have also included the importance of including not just cleanerfish but using the site as a proving ground for a wider raft of new technologies in louse control.

Things will doubtless be clearer post 17 March.
