

Scotland's environment watchdog has bowed to pressure from the salmon farming industry to keep the number of fish killed by diseases secret, according to internal correspondence seen by the Sunday Herald.

The **Scottish Environment Protection Agency (Sepa)** agreed to delete information on millions of fish deaths from a **public database** on fish farming launched this month because the **Scottish Salmon Producers' Association (SSPO)** argued it would be commercially damaging.

An anti-fish-farm campaigner has accused Sepa of acting like the industry's "lapdog". Because the database also omits crucial information on sea lice, it is no more than "spin", he claimed.

In February the **Sunday Herald revealed** that the number of farmed salmon killed by diseases had leapt to over 8.5 million in 2012. This compared to 6.8 million deaths in 2011 and 5.5 million in 2010, and was blamed mostly on the spread of **amoebic gill disease**.

A few days after the report appeared, SSPO's chairman, Phil Thomas, wrote to Sepa's chief executive, James Curran. He accused Sepa of "fundamentally poor regulatory practice", arguing that it had "no justifiable need" to collect and make available information on the numbers of fish mortalities.

"You were potentially placing information in the public domain which could be used to the commercial detriment or competitive market disadvantage of the companies submitting the data," Thomas wrote. "You were in fact providing competitor companies both within and outwith the UK with significant market and business information.

In reply, Curran said he understood SSPO's concerns. He promised that in future it would be made clear that for most fish farms supplying information on the number of deaths was voluntary.

Scotland's environmental watchdog has become the "lapdog" of the fish farming industry after agreeing to keep secret the vast number of farmed salmon killed by disease, it has been claimed.

The Scottish Environment Protection Agency (Sepa) agreed to delete information on more than 8 million dead fish from a public database on fish farming because the Scottish Salmon Producers' Association (SSPO) said that it would be commercially damaging.

The number of salmon killed by diseases at Scottish fish farms leapt to over 8.5 million last year, sparking fresh doubts about the sustainability of the £1 billion industry.

New figures released by the **Scottish Environment Protection Agency (Sepa)** reveal that losses from all salmon farms have reached nearly ten per cent of their production. The main problem has been the spread of Amoebic Gill Disease, blamed by some on the warmer seas caused by climate pollution.

A mountain of 13,627 tonnes of dead fish had to be disposed of in 2012 by 230 fish farms along the west coast and on the islands, compared to 9,717 tonnes in 2011 and 7,159 tonnes in 2010. The worst problems were in Shetland, where 2.4 million salmon died.

Sepa released detailed information about the deaths at fish farms over the last three years in response to a request from the Sunday Herald. The figures showed that the huge weight of prematurely dead fish that had to be disposed of nearly doubled between 2010 and 2012.

It was **Grieg Seafood**, which owns **Hjaltland Seafarms** in Shetland, that suffered the most mortalities, losing a massive 4,661 tonnes of salmon at 35 farms. Seven of the ten fish farms with the worst mortality rates were run by the company.

Second in the dead fish league was the foreign-owned **Scottish Salmon Company**, with 2,374 tonnes of mortalities at 39 farms. The other major operators – **Meridian Salmon**, **Marine Harvest** and **Scottish Sea Farms** – also suffered major losses (see tables below).

The total volumes harvested in Q2 2022 were 6,646 tonnes gutted weight (10,634 t_{gw}) - a change in volume of -38%. The harvested volumes for H1 2022 were 10,619 tonnes gutted weight (17,636 t_{gw}).

2.8 million (2.1 million) smolts were transferred to the sea in Q2 2022. In H1 2022, 5.1 million (3.7 million) smolts were transferred. This is in line with the smolt transfer plan.

Financial Performance

In Q2 2022, the operating revenue for the SCT farming segment was DKK 467 million (DKK 559 million). The operating revenue for the SCT farming segment for H1 2022 was DKK 701 million (DKK 881 million).

In Q2 2022, the SCT farming segment's EBIT amounted to DKK 312 million (DKK 122 million). For H1 2022, the SCT farming segment's EBIT amounted to DKK 375 million (DKK 81 million).

Operational EBIT amounted to DKK 41 million (DKK 53 million) in Q2 2022, corresponding to an operational EBIT margin of 9% (9%). In H1 2022, operational EBIT was DKK -12 million (DKK 46 million), corresponding to an operational EBIT margin of -2% (5%).

Operational EBIT/kg for the farming segment in Scotland was DKK 6.16 (DKK 4.97) in Q2 2022, which corresponds to NOK 8.29 (NOK 6.75). Operational EBIT/kg for H1 2022 was DKK -1.10 (DKK 2.58), corresponding to NOK -1.47 (NOK 3.54).

Costs of DKK 57 million (DKK 7 million) relate to incident-based mortality in Q2 2022, and for H1 2022, DKK 81 million (DKK 15 million).

In other words, production in 2022 was down 38% compared to 2021 and “incident-based mortality” in H1 2022 cost DKK 81 million. A similar story – a 43% fall in production and “incident-based mortality” of DKK 23 million was [reported in Q1 2022](#).

In Q1 2022, the operating revenue for the SCT farming segment was DKK 235 million (DKK 322 million).

In Q1 2022, the SCT farming segment's EBIT amounted to DKK 63 million (DKK -41 million).

Operational EBIT amounted to DKK -53 million (DKK -7 million) in Q1 2022, corresponding to an operational EBIT margin of -22% (-2%).

Operational EBIT/kg for the farming segment in Scotland was DKK -13.24 (DKK -1.04) in Q1 2022, which corresponds to NOK -17.67 (NOK -1.44).

Biological challenges impacted EBIT at the beginning of the period. Costs of DKK 23 million (DKK 8 million) relate to incident-based mortality in Q1 2022.

Bakkafrost's [2021 Annual Report](#) detailed a 15% fall in salmon farming production in Scotland. "For 2021, costs of DKK 262 million relate to incident-based mortality, compared to DKK 90 million for 2020," [stated Bakkafrost](#) (that's almost a trebling of mortality costs in a year!).



Financial results

Operational EBIT amounted to EUR 20.7 million in the second quarter (EUR 29.9 million), the equivalent of EUR 1.60 per kg (EUR 1.56 per kg). Poor production on stocks grown from externally sourced eggs negatively impacted volumes and costs compared with the second quarter of 2021. These eggs were introduced in the absence of other options following the EU-imposed export ban on Norwegian eggs in 2019. The negative effects above were partly offset by improved prices.

Costs and operations

Full cost per kg harvested increased from the comparable quarter due to the biological issues described above as well as negative scale effects from lower harvest volumes and increased feed cost.

Incident based mortality losses in the quarter amounted to EUR 2.8 million (EUR 1.5 million) mainly related to gill issues, treatment mortality and predators.

Mowi's [Integrated Annual Report 2021](#) cited for their salmon farming operations in Scotland (p37):

“EUR 12.9 million was recognised as incident-based mortality in 2021, compared with EUR 10.9 million in 2020. The 2021 incidents were related to different issues including AGD, treatment losses, CMS and gill issues. Growth challenges and elevated mortality on stocks grown from externally sourced eggs also contributed negatively”.


