Thanks a lot for sending this reminder. I've now submitted the quarterly returns for all our licences but one (WS21/2020/W). I just noticed an error was made when submitting one of the 48h returns: the wrong site name was introduced (Ardintoul instead of Kingairloch). Therefore, we submitted the information for the 48h return but with the wrong site name on it. I'm trying to edit the 48h return before submitting the quarterly one, but the software would not allow me to change site name. What should I do? Delete the existing return and create a new one? I'm worried this might be then recorded as a noncompliance. Your advice would be welcomed.

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Dear Licence holder,

MARINE (SCOTLAND) ACT 2010: PART 6 CONSERVATION OF SEALS

I write to you on behalf of the Marine Scotland - Licensing Operations Team ("MS-LOT"). MS-LOT is responsible, on behalf of the Scottish Ministers, for granting seal licences under Part 6 section 110 of the Marine (Scotland) Act 2010 ("the Act").

You are currently in possession of a seal licence for the 2020/2021 period.

The sending of a seal licence report is a requirement under section 113 of the Act and is a condition of your licence. The report must be submitted to the Licensing Authority within 10 days of the end of each quarterly period (the terms "quarterly report" and "quarterly period" have the meanings given in section 113(2) and (3) of the Act, respectively) . If no seals have been killed a nil return must be submitted.

As you will be aware, we are at the end of the Q1 period (ending on the 30 April 2020) as such returns are **now due, please complete these by the 10 May 2020**

Failure, without reasonable cause, to send a seal licence report is an offence under section 113(4) of the Act.

Section 128 of the Act states that *a person guilty of an offence under section 113(4) is liable, on summary conviction, to imprisonment for a term not exceeding 3 months or to a fine not exceeding level 5 on the standard scale, or to both.*

All returns must be made via our on-line reporting system which can be accessed [here](#): Once you have logged in, returns can be made by going to:

- Manage Licences:
- Under manage existing licences
 - o Green arrow – under Options
- Scroll down to:
 - o Modify Quarterly Return
- Finalise or Modify Return for this quarter
- Confirm returns.

If your licence is valid for any part of this reporting period but you have not shot any seals, you must still submit a return to confirm this.

If your licence validity dates fall out with this period no return will be required.

If you have made an error in reporting during the first quarter you can correct this now.


